

Dear Parishioners of Sandusky Catholic Community,



Greetings in Christ! I hope this letter finds you well. If you have just a few moments, I would love to share a beautiful opportunity with you and invite you to be part of a wonderful mission outreach.

I am writing on behalf of Franciscan University's Ecuador mission. The Ecuador mission is the only medical and catechetical mission on campus. We make the body and soul a focus of the mission because we recognize the universal call to love.

I am very excited about this mission and am getting ready to go. As a mission team, we are actively raising money to make this possible; each student will raise about \$2,200. I invite you to join us by helping us to serve the people of Ecuador.

Would you be so generous as to partner with us? Your gift will have immediate impact. Some results you will see and hear right away through photos and stories. But the real fruit of your gift will mature over years. Lives will be not just touched but changed—for the message we bring is the Gospel of Christ.

Thank you so much for your kindness and generosity. Please know that I shall indeed pray for you on this trip. During our travels, we specifically mention our benefactors and friends at Mass. Whether or not you can support us financially, please pray for the success of the mission, as prayer provides grace for those on the mission team, the people they reach, and the mission benefactors.



How I Came to Holy Angels Church

George A Riedy was a Sandusky St Mary's parishioner all his life. He was 24 years old when he was discharged from the Army after serving in WWII. His discharge came just in time to attend his sister's wedding at St Mary's. The reception was held in a relatives' house and my Dad was enlisted to be the bartender. In 1947, or at least in the Riedy family, the women remained upstairs at a wedding reception drinking punch and socializing while the men gathered in the basement where the bar was set up with alcohol. My Mother, Dorothy, a life-long Holy Angels parishioner, attended with her friend. Mom decided she was going to the basement where the "eligible bachelors" were located rather than remaining upstairs. She convinced her friend to go with her but Mother had to lead the way. As she went into the basement, my Dad looked up to see (according to him) "a beautiful pair of legs coming down the basement steps." My Dad told the men at the bar, "See those legs, men? That's the woman I'm going to marry." After a 6-month whirlwind romance, my parents decided to get married. They went to the priest at St Mary's Church where the priest told them they had to get married in the Bride's church. (Evidently, that was the custom at the time.) So, my disappointed father left and made an appointment with the priest at Holy Angels

Church. Father William Armitage married my parents on Thurs, Nov 27, 1947, Thanksgiving Day. My Dad not only became a parishioner of Holy Angels but also became a member of the Holy Angels Holy Name Society and the Knights of Columbus. Mv sister, Kathy, and I attended Holy Angels School until my parents could no longer afford to pay Single Bus to transport us the 7 miles to School. (No free public school busing back then.) My oldest sister, Anita, was married in Holy Angels. So, that's how my sisters and I came to Holy Angels Church. Did you know that Nov 27, 2014 will fall on Thanksgiving Day this year? We will have a Mass said then to celebrate our parents wedding 67 years ago in the Historic Holy Angels Church.
